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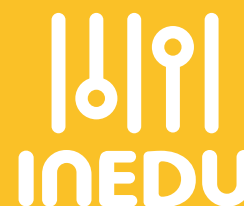

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## STUDENTS

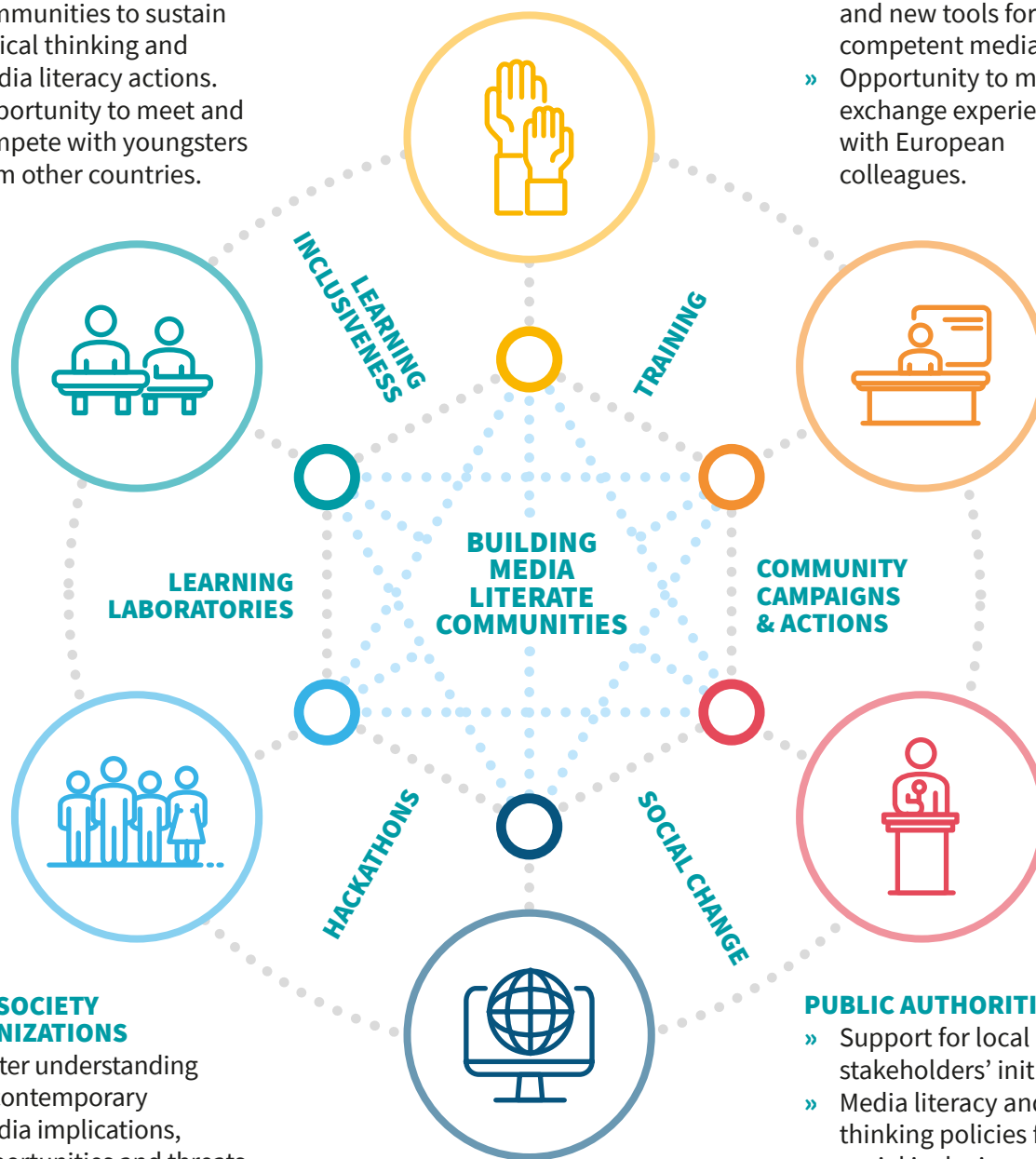
- » Empowered to take action within their communities to sustain critical thinking and media literacy actions.
